#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. ENTRY FEES: Noted in the prize list by each class and on entry forms.
- 1. Judges decisions are final.
- 2. The show management reserves the right to further cancel, combine or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
- 3. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC, MHC, NSHA, and ECRRA rule books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- 4. In classes where judging standards are listed, they are named in order of importance.
- 5. NSHA MEMBERSHIP NSHA Annual Award points accrue at each horse show for NSHA members. In performance classes the owner/lease of the horse must be a member and in equitation classes the rider must be the member. No points are to count until membership is paid. No exceptions. Membership applications are available from the show secretary the day of the show and can also be found on the NSHA Facebook page or our website at www.nshorsmens.org.
- 6. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted.
- 7. Entries close the Thursday before the show. Post entries will be accepted and charged a fee of \$15 for the day. No telephone entries.
- 8. The show committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts and not allow substitutions of classes or horses. No ring holds will be accepted for coaching conflicts between rings.
- 9. Proof of a negative Coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the show grounds. Tests must be dated within 6 months for out of state horses and within 12 months for MA horses.
- 10. Any entry found on the Judges card that has not been previously entered may be required to pay one and a half times the entry fee.
- 11. All returned checks will be charged a \$50 fee and entrants will not be allowed to compete unless all previous indebtedness to NSHA has been cleared. Any individual or farm that has two returned checks within one calendar year will be required to pay for entries in cash or money orders for the remainder of the year. Also, anyone who is suspended from any other equestrian organization will not be able to show until that indebtedness is paid in full.
- 12. Refunds of entries will not be made unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury or illness is shown. Refunds will be made if a class is cancelled.
- 13. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show committee, but the NSHA show and its employees will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall sign the entry blank holding the show blameless for any loss, accident or decision which may occur.
- 14. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED!!! We would prefer you leave your dogs at home but if you must bring them they have to be on a leash.
- 15. Schooling is permitted in the authorized areas only. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors.
- 16. All exhibitors are to dress properly in all classes.
- 17. It is suggested while mounted that you wear protective headgear while on the grounds.

- NEHC "B" MHC "C" **OPEN PONY IN HAND** 2. Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged individually standing and then at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To be judged on breed type, conformation, quality, substance, way of going, disposition and manners. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

#### WALK TROT DIVISION 10/UNDER NEHC "A" & MHC "C" PLEASURE NEHC "B" & MHC "C" EQUITATION

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Open to horses and ponies. Entries in this division are not eligible for any other class requiring entries to canter/lope. No child may compete who has previously entered in a class requiring entries to canter/lope. Restrictions apply to the rider and not the mount. Classes must be held an enclosed ring. May run as one division or divided (hunt seat, saddle seat or stock seat). Any child entered in Walk/Trot is eligible for Walk/Trot Pleasure.

- 11. WALK/TROT EQUITATION 10/UNDER To be shown English or Western at a walk, trot/jog only both ways of the ring. To be judged on the equitation of the rider only. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons
- 12. WALK/TROT PLEASURE 10/UNDER To be shown English or Western at a walk, trot/jog only both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse/pony to rider and performance. Trophy & 6 Ribbons Entry Fee \$25.00

38. NOVICE RIDER WALK/TROT/CANTER PLEASURE Open to Amateur riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in a pleasure class at a recognized show. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog, canter/lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners and performance. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

40. NOVICE RIDER WALK/TROT/CANTER PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP Same specifications as class 38. Must have entered and shown in class 38. Entry Fee \$35.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

#### REGISTERED MORGAN HORSE DIVISION NEHC & MHC "C"

Horses in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association and must be shown under their full registered name, of if under 1 year of age be eligible for registration. No obstacles in classes. Horses in championship classes will not be stripped.

#### 18. MORGAN HUNTER PLEASURE

To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter with a light rein but still maintain contact with the horse's mouth. To be judged 60% on manners, performance, quality, presence and the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride and 40% on type and conformation. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

Open to horses and ponies who are in their first or second year of showing and ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. There are no limitations as to the status of the rider. All seats and disciplines are welcome.

Shall be judged on exhibitor's ability to fit and show a halter horse. This class is not a halter class and should not be judged as such, the horse is merely a prop. To be shown in a suitable halter or bridle and proper attire. Pattern to be posted at the entry booth. Entry Fee \$25.00

Entries shall be judged individually, standing and then walk and trot on the line. Saddle type pintos may be stretched but all others should stand square. To be judged on conformation, quality, way of going, type and markings. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

#### 50. REGISTERED PAINT/PINTO OPEN PLEASURE

Horses to be shown under English or Western equipment. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring. Horses will be asked to back. To be judged on performance, manners, conformation, suitability, appointments and markings. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

at a walk and trot on the line. Horses should stand squarely and naturally and are not to be stretched. Horses to be handled and shown by one person only. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, action, substance, quality and manners. May be divided into stallions, mares and geldings. Classes may be divided further by age and sex, but only if the prize list so states. To be judged 40% on conformation, 20% type, 20% soundness, and 20% action. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons

- 56. OPEN APPALOOSA ENGLISH PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP Specifications to be the same as qualifying class 55. To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class 55. Entry Fee \$35.00 \$20, 15, 10, 5 & 6 Ribbons
- 63. OPEN APPALOOSA WESTERN PLEASURE To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. Exhibitors shall be asked to extend the jog in at least one direction. The Exhibitors shall be asked to lope with a slight increase in forward motion. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type and conformation, quality and substance and 10% on appointments. Silver not to count over a good working outfit. No martingales, tie downs or draw reins. Entry Fee \$25.00 Trophy & 6 Ribbons
- 64. OPEN APPALOOSA WESTERN PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP Specifications to be the same as qualifying class 63. To be eligible horses must have been entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class 63. Entry Fee \$35.00 \$20, 15, 10, 5 & 6 Ribbons

#### REGISTERED QUARTER HORSE DIVISION NEHC & MHC "A"

Horses must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association. Class specifications will be the same as the American Quarter Horse Association rule book and must be shown under full registered name on papers.

#### 45. QUARTER HORSE HALTER

May be divided into stallions, mares and geldings or a show may prefer to require mare and geldings or stallions and geldings to show together. May be divided further by age and sex but only if the prize list so states, all three divisions must be presented. No horse may enter in more than one halter class at any one show. Horses to be shown in hand at a walk and jog. To be judged on type, conformation, quality, substance and soundness. Hereditary or transmissible unsoundness shall disqualify a horse.



#### RANCH HORSE IN HAND

To be shown in a halter. SILVER SHOW HALTERS are discouraged. Classes will be divided MARES all ages, GELDINGS/STALLIONS all ages. All entries will be judged at a walk, trot & extended trot. Entries will line up at the judge's direction. To be judged 60% on correctness, balance, way of moving and conformation suitable for a working ranch type horse and 40% on manners & disposition. Show committees may ask for these classes to be combined depending on entries.

#### RANCH HORSE PLEASURE CLASS

The Ranch Horse Pleasure Class measures the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from one ranch task to another while riding with a group of horses or individually. The horse should be well-broke, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits. The horse should be ridden on a relatively loose rein with light contact and without requiring restraint. The horse should be responsive to the rider and make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner. The horse should be soft in the bridle and yield to contact. The ideal stock horse should have a natural, level headed carriage at each gait.

#### RANCH RIDING

The purpose of the ranch riding class is to measure the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from performing one ranch task to another. The horse should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse outside the confines of an arena. The horse should be well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal ranch horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate an obvious lengthening of stride at extended gaits. The horse can be ridden with light contact or on a light contact or on a relatively loose rein without requiring undue restraint, but not shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the ranch riding horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner, as well as the quality of the movement are of primary considerations. The ideal ranch riding horse should have a natural head carriage at each gait.
