## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. ENTRY FEES:** Noted in the prize list by each class and on entry forms.
- 1. Judges decisions** are final.
- 2. The show management reserves the right to further cancel, combine or divide classes** when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
- 3. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC, MHC, NSHA, and ECRR rule books and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.**
- 4. In classes where judging standards are listed, they are named in order of importance.**
- 5. NSHA MEMBERSHIP – NSHA Annual Award points accrue at each horse show for NSHA members. In performance classes the owner/lease of the horse must be a member and in equitation classes the rider must be the member. No points are to count until membership is paid. No exceptions. Membership applications are available from the show secretary the day of the show and can also be found on the NSHA Facebook page or our website at [www.nshorsmens.org](http://www.nshorsmens.org).**
- 6. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted.**
- 7. Entries close the Thursday before the show. Post entries will be accepted and charged a fee of \$15 for the day. No telephone entries.**
- 8. The show committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts and not allow substitutions of classes or horses. No ring holds will be accepted for coaching conflicts between rings.**
- 9. Proof of a negative Coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the show grounds. Tests must be dated within 6 months for out of state horses and within 12 months for MA horses.**
- 10. Any entry found on the Judges card that has not been previously entered may be required to pay one and a half times the entry fee.**
- 11. All returned checks will be charged a \$50 fee and entrants will not be allowed to compete unless all previous indebtedness to NSHA has been cleared. Any individual or farm that has two returned checks within one calendar year will be required to pay for entries in cash or money orders for the remainder of the year. Also, anyone who is suspended from any other equestrian organization will not be able to show until that indebtedness is paid in full.**
- 12. Refunds of entries will not be made unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury or illness is shown. Refunds will be made if a class is cancelled.**
- 13. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show committee, but the NSHA show and its employees will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall sign the entry blank holding the show blameless for any loss, accident or decision which may occur.**
- 14. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED!!! We would prefer you leave your dogs at home but if you must bring them they have to be on a leash.**
- 15. Schooling is permitted in the authorized areas only. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors.**
- 16. All exhibitors are to dress properly in all classes.**
- 17. It is suggested while mounted that you wear protective headgear while on the grounds.**

Open to riders 6 years of age and under riding English or Western, who may not have competed in any other class at any recognized show except for lead line. An adult over 18 is required to lead the entry. Handlers/riders must be properly dressed.

Open to riders 6 years of age and under riding English or Western. To be judged at the walk, trot/jog both ways of the ring. To be judged on equitation only.

Horses in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association and must be shown under their full registered name, of if under 1 year of age be eligible for registration. No obstacles in classes. Horses in championship classes will not be stripped.

18. **MORGAN HUNTER PLEASURE**  
To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter with a light rein but still maintain contact with the horse's mouth. To be judged 60% on manners, performance, quality, presence and the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride and 40% on type and conformation.

To be judged on conformation, quality, way of going, type and markings.

Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, action, substance, quality and manners. May be divided into stallions, mares and geldings. Classes may be divided further by age and sex, but only if the prize list so states. To be judged 40% on conformation, 20% type, 20% soundness, and 20% action.

Open to English horses . No martingales, tie downs or draw reins. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter on a reasonably loose rein both ways of the ring. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type, conformation quality and substance, and 10% on appointments.

Exhibitors shall be asked to extend the jog in at least one direction. The Exhibitors shall be asked to lope with a slight increase in forward motion. To be judged 60% on performance and manners, 30% on type and conformation, quality and substance and 10% on appointments. Silver not to count over a good working outfit. No martingales, tie downs or draw reins.

May be divided into stallions, mares and geldings or a show may prefer to require mare and geldings or stallions and geldings to show together. May be divided further by age and sex but only if the prize list so states, all three divisions must be presented. No horse may enter in more than one halter class at any one show. Horses to be shown in hand at a walk and jog. To be judged on type, conformation, quality, substance and soundness. Hereditary or transmissible unsoundness shall disqualify a horse.

Light contact with the horse's mouth is recommended. At the option of the judge, may be required to hand gallop one or both ways of the ring. At the hand gallop the judge may ask for the group to halt and stand quietly on a free rein.

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits to demonstrate their ability with different leads. At the option of the judge, horses may be asked to lengthen their stride at the walk or lope, one or both ways of the ring. It is mandatory that a moderate extension of the jog be asked for in at least one direction. Cadence and balance with smoothness is more essential than speed. Riders should sit at the moderated extension of the jog. Horses are required to back easily and stand quietly. Horses are to be reversed to the inside (away from the rail). They may be required to reverse at the walk or jog at the discrimination of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope. Judge may ask for additional work of the same nature from any horse. He is not to ask for work other than that listed above. This class will be judged on the performance and conformation of the horse at the discretion of the judge. Entries will be penalized for excessive speed or being on wrong leads.

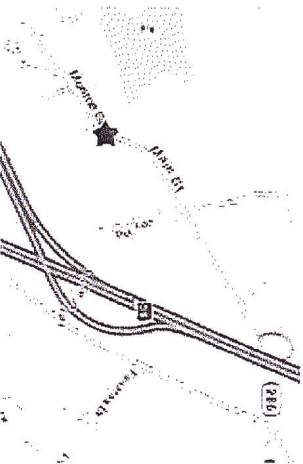
Bob-Lyn Stables is on the Amesbury/Salisbury, MA line, conveniently located off rt. I-95, exit 60.

### Address

91 Monroe St., Amesbury, MA 01913. Most direct route and preferable for horse trailers and vans:

### From the South

I-95 N to exit 60, rt. 286/Salisbury. (Or I-495 N to It.) Turn right at fork off ramp before traffic light (Mobil station on right), and turn right at next light. Proceed West on this road (rt. 286, Main St., Salisbury) approximately 1 mile. You will pass back over rt. 95 and past entrance to I-95 S. Go past Rolex Replica Sale Johnson Lumber on left. (Road becomes Monroe St., Amesbury.) See Bob-Lyn Stables sign on left. Drive past house/barns to parking on left.



### From the North

I-95 S to exit 60, rt. 286/Salisbury. Bear right off exit past Rest Area, continue on ramp to right turn before traffic light, Mobil station on right. Follow same directions above from here.

## RANCH HORSE IN HAND

To be shown in a halter. SILVER SHOW HALTERS are discouraged. Classes will be divided MARES all ages, GELDINGS/STALLIONS all ages. All entries will be judged at a walk, trot & extended trot. Entries will line up at the judge's direction. To be judged 60% on correctness, balance, way of moving and conformation suitable for a working ranch type horse and 40% on manners & disposition. Show committees may ask for these classes to be combined depending on entries.

## RANCH HORSE PLEASURE CLASS

The Ranch Horse Pleasure Class measures the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from one ranch task to another while riding with a group of horses or individually. The horse should be well-broke, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits. The horse should be ridden on a relatively loose rein with light contact and without requiring restraint. The horse should be responsive to the rider and make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner. The horse should be soft in the bridle and yield to contact. The ideal stock horse should have a natural, level headed carriage at each gait.

## RANCH RIDING

The purpose of the ranch riding class is to measure the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from performing one ranch task to another. The horse should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse outside the confines of an arena. The horse should be well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal ranch horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate an obvious lengthening of stride at extended gaits. The horse can be ridden with light contact or on a light contact or on a relatively loose rein without requiring undue restraint, but not shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the ranch riding horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner, as well as the quality of the movement are of primary considerations. The ideal ranch riding horse should have a natural head carriage at each gait.
